## Welcome to the Redstone Commodity Update 2016: Q2

This quarter has been certainly exciting with plenty to keep us all busy and on our toes. From the UK's vote to leave the European Union, recent reductions in commodities supply and a rallying of the markets for much of 2016, there has been a hive of activity.

We have seen hiring on both ends of the seniority spectrum. Some outfits have sought to fill senior leadership posts to provide guidance and there has been an equal interest in more junior level candidates to cheaply fill the shoes over more expensive traders that may have departed. There may be a reduction in commodities supply but there certainly is not one in available global talent.

#### **Noteworthy Energy Talent Moves**


Energy has been Q2's busiest sector, especially in clean fuels with a number of headline hires in Europe and the USA as trading houses and hedge funds are investing heavily in traders covering LNG and natural gas. Noble Group's problems mount following Richard Elman stepping down as Chairman and the resignation of Chief Executive Officer Yusuf Alireza. Due to the recent market rally we have received well above average inquiries for traders who cover the traditional domestic markets.

Jeremy Taylor has joined Goldman Sachs as Co-head of Global Commodities and Partner in New York, USA. Jeremy headed the US power and gas unit at Mercuria Energy Group and formerly also worked for Bank of America Merrill Lynch as Head of North American Commodities Trading. He will start his assignment at Goldman Sachs in August later this year and work together with Ed Emerson, the other co-head.

Citi has appointed **Stuart Smith** as Head of Asia-Pacific Commodities in Singapore. He will look after the risk management and financing solutions for commodities. Previously, Stuart was Head of Asian Commodity Sales and Structuring at Deutsche Bank and most recently, Global Head of Commodities Structuring at Commonwealth Bank of Australia. In Norway, ex-BNP Paribas Head of Oil and Energy Sales for EMEA **Mads Hultgreen** has joined Nordea Markets as Chief Sales Manager.

Pierre Barbe has been hired by Vitol Group as Head of Africa to be based in London, UK. Pierre was Head of Trading and Shipping at TOTSA Total Oil Trading. He had started his career at Total in 1983 and left his previous position in 2014.

Engelhart Commodities Trading Partners has appointed Mitka Corby as



Global Head of Oil Trading in Singapore. The oil trader worked most recently for Vitol Group and has about 15 years' experience with Trafigura. **Taraneh Azad** has joined Hartree Partners as Head of European Origination and will start her new position this autumn. Previously, Taraneh worked for Goldman Sachs as Managing Director of Commodities Sales. Former BP Head of Eastern Hemisphere Fuel Oil Trading **lain Welsh** has joined Socar Trading as Managing Director in Singapore.

Millennium Management has hired Philip Sutterby, Ray Eyles, Steven Frost, Walter (Thompson) Tambke and Roman Romero. Philip has left Mercuria Energy Group where he was employed as Head of European Natural Gas Trading and he will join the hedge fund to look after a new European power, gas and coal portfolio in London, UK. Ray has joined Millennium as Commodity Portfolio Manager in Singapore. Most recently, Ray traded for Trafigura and Galena Asset Management (Asia), the equities and macro derivatives hedge fund of Trafigura. Formerly, he had been Head of Commodities for Asia at J.P. Morgan.

In the USA, Steven and Walter have been employed as Portfolio Managers for Millennium's office in Connecticut and New York respectively. Steven was a former Natural Gas Trader and Partner at BTG Pactual and had spent over 17 years at Phibro before joining Noble Group. Walter also traded for BTG Pactual recently and he had covered energy and agricultural commodities trading at Noble Group and Hess Corporation. In addition, Roman joined the

multi-strategy hedge fund to focus on oil research. Roman was Head of Oil Research at LCM Commodities and formerly also at Citadel Investment Group.

Looking at the LNG industry in the UK, Gabriel Gonzalez Laguna and Alejandro Sanchez Gestido have left Noble Group to join Glencore. Previously, both had been working for Bank of America Merrill Lynch. Gabriel, most recently Noble's Global Head of LNG Trading and Origination, has been appointed as Head of LNG Trading and Alejandro, ex-Global Head of LNG Supply and Sales at Noble, has been named Head of LNG Supply and Sales. At the same time, Noble has hired Lou Montilla as Head of LNG Origination. Lou was Glencore's Head of LNG Business Development and looking after the implementation of a new LNG entry strategy. Furthermore, LNG Trader Rajiv Panicker has departed from Glencore to start trading for Centrica as LNG Manager in London. In Singapore, Sid Bambawale has joined Vitol Group. The former Senior LNG Trader at Chevron will be Vitol's LNG Trading Manager. Prior to Chevron, Sid traded for Citi and BP.


Chemium International has employed **Stuart Strong** as European Aromatics Manager to be based in London. He will be trading and supplying aromatics and associated products. Most recently, Stuart was Broker for methanol and ethanol at Vitol Group. Also in London, **Steve Barclay** has joined Andurand Capital Management, a hedge fund focused on the oil and energy industry and led by Pierre Andurand. Steve, a former Jet Fuel, Gasoline and Light-ends Trader, was most recently trading for Mercuria Energy Group. Additionally, **Rahul Eapen**, a Senior Energy Marketer, has left Mercuria to join Castleton Commodities International in Singapore. Ex-Bank of America Merrill Lynch Oil Derivatives Trader **Gavin Dhillon** has joined Petroineos Trading in London. At BAML, Gavin focused on swaps and options trading across crude oil, distillates, gasoline and fuel oil.

### **Noteworthy Metal Talent Moves**

In Q2, hiring in the metals sector was defined by plans to strengthen core business operations. After BHP Billiton's restructuring of management in Q1, also Chief Executive Officer of Rio Tinto Group Jean-Sebastien Jacques put emphasis on reconsolidation, focusing on the aluminium, iron ore and copper businesses and reshuffling his chiefs accordingly. In Singapore, metals trader Kyen Resources has increased their trading assets by purchasing the last remains of Gunvor Group's metals book. Despite market outlooks and recent Brexit uncertainties, we have seen a rising appetite to hire in Asia in the metals industry.

Rene van der Kam, most recently with Gunvor Group, has set up base metals trading company Viant Commodities in Singapore and Hong Kong with plans to open another office in Shanghai. The company focuses on trading copper, nickel, zinc and aluminium. Former Head of Metals China at Gunvor Group Julie Yingping Zhu has joined Rene at Valiant Commodities. Both Rene and Julie had previously worked for Noble Group.

Constellium has appointed Jean-Marc Germain as Chief Executive Officer in New York to succeed the retired Pierre Vareille. Previously, Jean-Marc was President at Novelis for North



America and most recently he held the positions of President and Chief Executive Officer at Algeco Scotsman Group which provides business services for secure portable storages and modular space. Jack Govers has joined Aleris in Belgium as President for Europe and Global Markets. He relocated from the Netherlands where he was employed at the petrochemicals manufacturer SABIC in a senior Managing Director position. Novelis has rehired their former Head of Sales and Marketing Sachin Satpute as President for Novelis Asia. Based in South Korea, Sachin will look after Novelis's Asia-Pacific operations. Most recently, he was with Hindalco Industries as Chief Marketing Officer. In addition, Devinder Ahuja has joined Novelis as Senior Finance Vice President to become Chief Financial Officer in August later this year. He joined Novelis from Alcon USA which belongs to the pharmaceutical company Novartis. At Novelis, Devinder will be based at their headquarters in Atlanta, USA.

Gerald Group has appointed **Brian Ahern** as Vice President in Stamford, Connecticut. The metal trader was most recently Senior Vice President at Freepoint Commodities. **Marcel Dietsch** has joined Engelhart Commodities Trading Partners as Proprietary Trader in London, UK. 
#### **Noteworthy Ags & Softs Talent Moves**

After a busy start to the year, the ags and softs sector proved steady in Q2 in terms of recruitment. Chinese companies are strengthening their presence in the Brazilian grains market and increasing the pressure on local firms. Louis Dreyfus and ADM are reportedly struggling with the fall in crop prices over the last few years while energy players Hartree Partners and Freepoint Commodities see new opportunities, opening new agricultural trading desks in the UK and USA.

Former Citi Group Agricultural Traders Samrat Sharma and Jonathan Pierre have joined Hartree Partners in London, UK. Samrat has been hired to head Hartree's move into the agricultural business, covering grains, oilseeds as well as soft commodities trading. At Citi, he was a Director for the ags and softs trading desk. Prior to Citi, Samrat also worked for Louis Dreyfus Commodities. Jonathan was Citi Group's Lead Trader for the corn and soybeans complex and will trade grains and oilseeds derivatives at Hartree Partners.
